FOSTER PROGRAM POLICIES

GIVE THE FOSTER ANIMAL LOTS OF ATTENTION AND AFFECTION.

The animal may have lived a difficult life before coming to your home. Your love and attention will help heal the animal's psychological wounds. Foster families are important to our organization because they help socialize our kittens and get them ready for a seamless transition into their forever home.

ATTEND PAPA'S PET PROJECT'S FOSTER HOME TRAINING.

Attend Papa's Pet Project Foster Home Training, always ask for help when needed and update Papa's Pet Project weekly about the status of the foster cats/kittens. Before you bring home a foster animal we recommend that you learn as much as you can about caring for that particular type of animal. Read about feeding, grooming, and training. Read about what type of behavior to expect from the animal. Study warning signs that may indicate the animal needs veterinary attention.

BE PREPARED TO MAKE A FINANCIAL COMMITMENT.

Being a non-profit organization we depend entirely on public donations. We will provide food and medications as funding allows. We will also provide you with any equipment you may need if we have it available. Veterinary care will be provided through our contracted Veterinarians.

KEEP FOSTER ANIMALS AWAY FROM YOUR OWN PETS, AT LEAST INITIALLY.

A foster pet may come into your home harboring contagious diseases. Even though your pets are vaccinated against many diseases, it's a good idea to keep the foster animal away from your pets for at least a week as an added precaution.

KEEP YOUR ANIMALS UP-TO-DATE ON THEIR VACCINATIONS.

All animals should be current on vaccinations that protect them from diseases. Before you bring home a foster animal, consult your veterinarian to make sure your own animals have received the preventive treatment they need to keep them safe.

BRING THE FOSTER PET TO SCHEDULED ADOPTION EVENTS.

Papa's Pet Project, Inc. depends on you to make its program work. We try and schedule events to allow exposure to the animals in the program, and it is a necessary part of the foster program for the foster parents to have dependable transportation to these events.

DISCUSS YOUR PLANS WITH EVERYONE IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD.

Fostering requires a lot of time and energy-both emotional and physical. Animals have feelings and can sense when they are not wanted.
